

Drilling commences at Cuisinier-3 oil appraisal well

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Senex Energy Limited has been advised by Santos Limited, the operator of the ATP 752P Joint Venture, that the Cuisinier-3 oil appraisal well has commenced drilling and is at a depth of 75 metres and drilling ahead to the 9 5/8 inch surface casing setting depth of approximately 310 metres.

Cuisinier-3 is 750 metres to the south east of Cuisinier-1, the discovery well for the Cuisinier Murta Oil Field and is planned to be drilled to a total depth of 2,028 metres.

The primary targets are sands of the Murta Formation with secondary targets in the Birkhead Formation and Hutton Sandstone.

Cuisinier-3 is located in the Barta Block, ATP 752P, in the Cooper Basin in south west Queensland.
