1. Statement of significant accounting policies

Statement of compliance

This general purpose financial report for the half-year reporting period ended 31 December 2010 has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *Corporations Act 2001* and Accounting Standard AASB 134 *Interim Financial Reporting.*

The half-year financial report does not include full disclosures of the type normally included in an annual financial report. Basis of preparation

The financial statements are prepared on an accrual basis and are based on historical costs. No critical accounting estimates and/or assumptions have been made during the preparation of the financial report.

Adoption of new and revised accounting standards

In the half-year ended 31 December 2010, all of the new and revised Standards and Interpretations issued by the AASB that are relevant to its operations and effective for annual reporting periods beginning on or after 1 July 2010 have been reviewed.

It has been determined that there is no impact, material or otherwise, of the new and revised Standards and Interpretations on the operations of the Company and Consolidated Entity its business and, therefore, no change is necessary to Company accounting policies.

Going Concern Basis

Accumulated costs in relation to any abandoned area will be written off in full against profit in the year in which the decision to abandon the area is made. When production commences, the accumulated costs for the relevant area of interest will be amortised over the life of the area according to the rate of depletion of the economically recoverable reserves. A regular review will be undertaken of each area of interest to determine the appropriateness of continuing to carry forward costs in relation to that area of interest.

The entity had incurred a loss for the half year ended 31 December 2010 of \$360,172 (2009 loss: \$228,148). The ability of the entity to continue as a going concern is subject to the successful recapitalisation of the Company. In the event that the Board is not successful in recapitalising the Company and in raising further funds, the entity may not be able to continue in its present form and may not be able to meet its planned commitments.
