

Oil shows at Cuisinier-3 Appraisal Well, Barta Block, ATP 752P, Cooper Basin

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Senex Energy Limited has been advised by Santos Limited, the operator of the ATP 752P Joint Venture, that the Cuisinier-3 oil appraisal well has been cased and suspended as a potential producing well and plans to carry out future cased hole formation testing.

Cuisinier-3 was drilled to a total depth of 2,040 metres with five and a half inch production casing run.

Oil shows were observed while drilling in the target upper Murta Formation with wire line log interpretation indicating five to six metres of net oil pay with good porosity.

Oil shows were also observed over approximately four metres within the lower Murta Formation sand, with further oil shows seen within basal Birkhead Formation and Hutton Sandstone sands.

Determination of the extent and commercial nature of the interpreted Murta Formation oil zone and Birkhead and Hutton oil shows within Cuisinier-3 and the two previous wells, Cuisinier-2 and Barta North-1 is anticipated by the Operator to be carried out by cased hole tests within the next two months.

Cuisinier-3 is 750 metres south east of the Murta oil producing well Cuisinier-1.
