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DECMIL GROUP AWARDED A\$71M CONTRACT FOR WARRAWANDU VILLAGE

Key Points

- **Awarded A\$71M contract to install buildings for accommodation facility in WA Pilbara region.**
- **Second contract for accommodation village awarded to Decmil in March 2011.**
- **Work to start immediately for expected completion in October 2012.**

The Decmil Group Limited (**ASX:DCG**) ("DGL") today announced its wholly-owned subsidiary, Decmil Australia Pty Ltd, has been awarded a A\$71million contract by BHP Billiton Iron Ore to install permanent accommodation at the Warrawandu Village in Western Australia's Pilbara region.

Decmil Group CEO Scott Criddle said the award of this contract lifts the company's order book for work in hand for 2011/2012 to approximately \$250M.

The Warrawandu Village is to be located approximately 25km east of Newman.

The scope of this contract is to design and construct the Warrawandu Village and also includes the detailed design, supply, installation, fit-out and commissioning of a number of in-situ built industrial buildings including: a bulk storage building, facilities management maintenance workshop, and waste management facility.

"This is a multi-faceted project that includes extensive civil and infrastructure works. It will draw on Decmil Australia's broad capabilities across its three operating divisions and will further demonstrate the capacity of Decmil's expanding Civil Division to deliver all elements of complex projects including construction of villages and non-process infrastructure," he said.

Mr Criddle said "the phased construction and handover of accommodation and associated infrastructure is evidence of Decmil's responsiveness to client's needs."

Work on the contract will start immediately and is scheduled to be completed in October 2012.

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
