

## SYAMA OPERATIONS UPDATE

Resolute Mining Limited advises of the commencement of a planned maintenance shutdown at its Syama operations.

An extensive review and overhaul of the maintenance regime of the plant over the past 12 months had identified areas within the crushing and milling circuits that were impacting on performance and these areas are being addressed through this planned shut.

This maintenance work will occur during the first half of April after which a six week direct leach ore campaign will commence. This will allow maintenance work also to be undertaken on the sulphide section of the plant, including some refractory replacement in the roaster and inspection of the stack.

The planned April maintenance shut is an important step for the Syama operation as the issues being addressed will further improve the reliability of the processing plant allowing annual design throughput to be achieved. Metallurgical performance of the mill, floatation and roaster operation which continue to meet expectations will also be enhanced by improved reliability.
