# ASX ANNOUNCEMENT/MEDIA RELEASE CUADRILLA UPDATE – BOWLAND SHALE OPERATIONS

AJ Lucas wishes to advise the current status of activities conducted by Cuadrilla Resources in relation to its prospect in the Bowland Shale in Lancashire, UK.

### Preese Hall #1

Fraccing of this well commenced 29 March 2011 and is continuing. The bottom three stages have been fracced and flowback and cleanup operations are underway. Currently a coil tubing unit is being used to remove the frac bridge plugs.

Following completion of fraccing at Preese Hall around the middle of May 2011, the fraccing unit will relocate to Hungary to commence operations at the THL BA-E-1 well, located in southern Hungary near the villages of Balotaszallas and Tompa.

## Grange Hill #1

This well spudded on 16 January 2011 and is currently at a depth of 6,474 feet. Due to problems associated with washing out at approximately 5,300 feet, the well has been reengineered and casing inserted to 5,700 feet. Cementing operations have been conducted and drilling is again underway. Thus far, geologic indications from this well are as expected. Drilling and coring is expected to be completed by 20 May 2011.

The Company is planning to release a more comprehensive market update on its oil and gas investments in the near future.
