Ainsworth Game Technology – FY11 Profit Guidance

Ainsworth Game Technology Limited (AGT) today provided guidance that based on unaudited internal management accounts it was expecting to announce a profit after tax in the range of \$11 - \$13 million for the financial year ending 30 June 2011. This compares to a reported loss of \$2.7 million in the corresponding period in 2009.

AGT announced a half year profit of \$3.3 million on 24 February 2011 and expected the profit for the second half of the 2011 financial year to be more than double that of the first half of FY11.

Further strong operating cash flows resulting from increased domestic revenues have allowed the Company to continue its on-market buy-back of its Convertible Notes (ASX Code: AGIG).

The Company advised that the improved financial result was predominately driven by continued strong performance across its range of games on its Ambassador SL and recently launched A560 gaming products. The Company further advised that it had commenced the approval process of its A560 products in Nevada.

The Company's Chief Executive Officer, Mr Danny Gladstone, said, "We are very pleased with the financial performance achieved to date, which is a direct result of the Company's previous investment in product initiatives. Ongoing research and development of new and innovative gaming products is expected to result in sustainable growth in coming periods."

"The planned investment in building a greater presence in North America is expected to position the Company for further international growth in FY12, as global economic conditions improve," Mr Gladstone said.

Executive Chairman, Mr LH Ainsworth said, "I am pleased with the progress made in the current period and the Company continues to establish itself as a leading edge provider of innovative gaming equipment to its customers."

"These results are testament to the commitment and hard work of AGT's experienced board, strong management team and dedicated staff," Mr Ainsworth said.

The Company is expecting to release its results for the full year ending 30 June 2011 on 25 August 2011.
