



Drilling underway on Vintage Crop-1 exploration well in the South Australian Cooper Basin

Senex Energy Limited (Senex) advises that the Vintage Crop-1 exploration well in South Australian Cooper Basin permit PEL 516 (Senex 100%) spudded on Tuesday 24 May at 16:00 and is expected to reach a total depth of 2,075 metres in 23 days.

Vintage Crop-1 will assess five potentially oil-bearing zones of the Cretaceous and Jurassic Eromanga sequence before being deepened to evaluate the unconventional gas potential of underlying coals and shales.

At 06:00 this morning the well was at 594 metres and drilling ahead to the surface casing depth of 800 metres.

Vintage Crop-1 is Senex's first appraisal of the unconventional gas potential of its Cooper Basin acreage and will inform future efforts to unlock a potentially massive new fuel source in the region, referred to in an April 2011 US Energy Information Administration (**EIA**) report.

The EIA is the statistical and analytical agency within the US Department of Energy. In a review of *World Shale Gas Resources: An Initial Assessment of 14 Regions Outside the United States*¹, the US EIA included an estimate of 85 trillion cubic feet (**Tcf**) of recoverable shale gas in Australia's Cooper Basin. The evaluation of the underlying coals and shales in Vintage Crop-1 will further define this potential.

Vintage Crop-1 is located approximately 65 kilometres south east of Moomba, close to Santos' oil-producing Narcoonowie and Caroowinnie fields.


