Turton-1 Spud Notice

Dear Shareholders,

Monday 30 May 2011

We are pleased to announce that the Turton-1 exploration well in PEL92 spudded at 17:00 hours on Saturday 28 May 2011. The surface hole has been drilled to 638 metres and the current operation is running the 95/8" surface casing.

The well's primary objective is the Namur Sandstone with secondary objectives in the Birkhead and Poolowanna Formations. Turton-1 is located 11 km to the southwest of the Butlers-1 and 14.1 km to the west of the Brighton-1 wells. The well will be drilled to a total depth of about 1,745 metres and is expected to take 8 days to drill and evaluate.

The Namur Sandstone primary target, which is the oil reservoir in the Butlers oil field, is estimated to contain 4.66¹ million barrels of Prospective Resources (P50). The deeper formations would be expected to add to this estimate if they result in discovery.

Further ASX releases on Turton -1 will be made when appropriate.
