Australian Agricultural Company Limited - Request for Trading Halt - Listing Rule 17.1

Australian Agricultural Company Limited (the "**Company**") requests a trading halt in its shares to commence prior to commencement of trading today, Wednesday 8 June 2011.

In accordance with the requirements of Listing Rule 17.1 the Company requests a trading halt pending an announcement regarding the impact on the Company of the Federal Government's decision announced today to suspend the export of all live cattle to Indonesia.

The Company requests that the trading halt continue until the opening of trading on Friday 10 June 2011 or the Company makes an earlier announcement.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
