



## Sampdoria-1 Exploration Well Result

Sampdoria-1 Oil Exploration Well Drilling Report Wompi Block, ATP 752P, Cooper Basin, South West Queensland.

Senex Energy Limited has been advised by Santos Limited, the operator of the ATP 752P Joint Venture, that the Sampdoria-1 oil exploration well has been plugged and abandoned after reaching a depth of 1,823m in the Toolachee Formation. Shows were recorded in the Murta Formation and Hutton Sandstone and a Drill Stem Test was conducted across the show at the top of the Hutton Sandstone. The test recovered 2.8bbls of mud-cut formation water.

Sampdoria-1 is located approximately 4 kilometres to the north east of the Genoa oil field and planned to be drilled to a total depth of 1,835 metres. The primary targets were sands of the basal Birkhead Formation and Hutton Sandstone with secondary targets in the McKinlay Member and Namur Formation.

Senex Energy participated in the drilling of Sampdoria-1 at no cost for its 22.75% working interest in the well.




Figure 1: Sampdoria-1 well location
