

Long serving Director retires from Senex Board

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The longest serving Director of Senex Energy Limited, Mr Robert J Pett, has resigned from the Board after almost three decades with the business, due to his growing commitments with other publicly listed resource companies.

Senex Chairman Denis Patten thanked Mr Pett for his extensive contribution to the business since its inception, including serving as the company's Chairman until 2008.

"Bob played a crucial role in the establishment of the company, including listing on the Australian Stock Exchange in 1984. Over 28 years, he has made a substantial contribution and provided valuable advice and strategic direction. His broad knowledge and experience in the global resource sector has made him a valued member of the Board," he said.

Mr Pett cited his growing commitments with other resource sector companies as the reason for his resignation.

"It is with regret that I resign from the board of Senex. It has been a very interesting ride and extremely pleasing to see the company grow in recent years into an emerging force in the Australian oil and gas sector.

"But with this growth and my other commitments including the companies I chair, it is becoming increasingly difficult for me to give the company the time and attention it deserves," he said.

Mr Pett's resignation is effective immediately.

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
