



## Successful Growler-6 appraisal well to be a future oil producer

Senex Energy Limited (Senex), as operator for the PRL 15 Joint Venture, advises that the Growler-6 appraisal well has been successfully drilled, cored and cased and suspended as a future production well.

Core and wire line logs confirmed the presence of a 17 metre gross oil column in the Birkhead Formation over the interval 1,735 to 1,752 metres with interpreted net oil pay of at least six metres.

Growler-6 is the first well in the Joint Venture's 11 well exploration and appraisal drilling program in PRL 15 and PEL 104, which comprises five appraisal wells and six exploration wells located in the highly prospective Birkhead channel play on the western flank of the South Australian Cooper Basin.

Senex Managing Director Ian Davies said "this result confirms our interpretation of the 3D seismic survey of the mid-Birkhead Formation stratigraphic play in Senex's western flank permits."

"For Senex's shareholders, it confirms our geological modelling and supports our confidence in the company's production target of over 700,000 barrels of oil for 2011/12," he said.

Senex Energy holds a 60% interest in PRL 15 and PEL 104 and is operator of the joint ventures, with the remaining 40% interest held by Beach Energy Limited.




Figure 1: Growler-6 well location
