SYDNEY – 25 May 2012 – International automotive industry IT developer, Infomedia Ltd, today announced it had entered into a new data license agreement with Hyundai MOBIS to produce and supply its Microcat® brand electronic parts catalogue (EPC).

Korean-based Hyundai MOBIS is the parts supply company for Hyundai and KIA dealers around the world. Hyundai dealers commenced using Microcat in 2001 and KIA dealers in 2008. The new agreement grants Infomedia the non-exclusive rights to supply Microcat for three years globally, except for China and Korea.

Infomedia's Microcat EPC has led innovation across the industry since it was first introduced in Australia in 1990. In recent years it has made the successful transition from being a DVD-based software product to being the leading, fully online, cloud-based EPC offering. Microcat LIVE, which is already in use for other automotive dealers, will now be available for Hyundai and KIA dealers globally to help improve their fixed operations, productivity and service.
