



Exploration success at the Cuisinier North-1 oil well in the Queensland Cooper Basin

Senex Energy Limited (Senex) has been advised by Santos Limited, the operator of the ATP 752P joint venture in the Queensland Cooper Basin, that the Cuisinier North-1 oil exploration well will be cased and suspended as a future oil producer after successfully intersecting a 5.0 metre gross oil column.

The Cuisinier North-1 exploration well spudded on 2 July 2012 and reached a total depth of 2,066 metres on 8 July 2012. Wire line logs indicate the presence of a 5.0 metre gross oil column in the oil-bearing sands of the Murta Formation over the interval 1,646.0 to 1,661.0 metres with interpreted net oil pay of 2.0 metres.

Cuisinier North-1 is the last of four wells to be drilled in the Barta Block in the current drilling campaign.

Senex holds a 15% interest in ATP 752P (Barta Block).
