PRICE AND VOLUME QUERY

We refer to the email received 31 July 2012, referring to recent changes in the market price of shares in YTC Resources Limited ("YTC" or the "Company") and the volume of trading.

In response to your queries, we advise as follows:

1. Is the Company aware of any information concerning it that has not been announced which, if known, could be an explanation for recent trading in the securities of the Company?

The Company is not aware of any information concerning it that has not been announced which, if known, could be an explanation for recent trading in the securities of the company.

The Company released its 30 June quarterly report on Thursday 26 July 2012 which fully informs the market of the Company's recent activities. In this quarterly report the Company advised the market that it anticipated receiving approvals shortly from the NSW State Government for mining at the Hera Project and that the Company had made progress towards negotiating funding for the Hera mine. The Hera funding negotiations remain confidential and no further announcement has yet been made on Hera Project approvals, nor is any update available to be reported at this time.

2. If the answer to question 1 is yes, can an announcement be made immediately? If not, why not and when is it expected that an announcement will be made?

3. Is there any other explanation that the Company may have for the price change and increase in volume in the securities of the Company?

The Company is not aware of any reason for the change in price in recent days. The increase in volume in recent days is the result of several on-market crossing transactions that have been executed on the ASX.

PRICE and VOLUME QUERY

We have noted a change in the price of the Company's securities from 24 cents on 23 July 2012 to an intra day low of 20 cents today. There has also been a significant increase in the volume of shares traded.

In light of the price and volume change, please respond to each of the following questions.

- 1. Is the Company aware of any information concerning it that has not been announced which, if known, could be an explanation for recent trading in the securities of the Company?
 - Please note that as recent trading in the Company's securities could indicate that information has ceased to be confidential, the Company is unable to rely on the exceptions to listing rule 3.1 contained in listing rule 3.1A when answering this question.
- 2. If the answer to question 1 is yes, can an announcement be made immediately? If not, why not and when is it expected that an announcement will be made?
 - Please note, if the answer to question 1 is yes and an announcement cannot be made immediately, you need to contact us to discuss this and you need to consider a trading halt (see below).
- 3. Is there any other explanation that the Company may have for the price and volume change in the securities of the Company?
- 4. Please confirm that the Company is in compliance with the listing rules and, in particular, listing rule 3.1.

Unless the information is required immediately under listing rule 3.1, a response is requested as soon as possible and, in any event, **not later than 05:30 pm (W.S.T) today**.

Under listing rule 18.7A, a copy of this query and your response will be released to the market, so your response should be in a suitable form and separately address each of the questions asked. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact me immediately.

Listing rule 3.1

Listing rule 3.1 requires an entity to give ASX immediately any information concerning it that a reasonable person would expect to have a material effect on the price or value of the entity's securities. The exceptions to this requirement are set out in listing rule 3.1A.

In responding to this letter you should consult listing rule 3.1 and Guidance Note 8 – Continuous Disclosure: listing rule 3.1.

If the information requested by this letter is information required to be given to ASX under listing rule 3.1 your obligation is to disclose the information immediately.

Your responsibility under listing rule 3.1 is not confined to, or necessarily satisfied by, answering the questions set out in this letter.

Trading halt

If you are unable to respond by the time requested, or if the answer to question 1 is yes and an announcement cannot be made immediately, you should consider a request for a trading halt in the Company's securities. As set out in listing rule 17.1 and Guidance Note 16 – Trading Halts we may grant a trading halt at your request. We may require the request to be in writing. We are not required to act on your request. You must tell us each of the following.

- The reasons for the trading halt.
- How long you want the trading halt to last.
- The event you expect to happen that will end the trading halt.
- That you are not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
- Any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt, or that we ask for.

The trading halt cannot extend past the commencement of normal trading on the second day after the day on which it is granted. If a trading halt is requested and granted and you are still unable to reply to this letter before the commencement of trading, suspension from quotation would normally be imposed by us from the commencement of trading if not previously requested by you. The same applies if you have requested a trading halt because you are unable to release information to the market, and are still unable to do so before the commencement of trading.
