DRILLING REPORT - 8 November 2012

WELL NAME: Taza 1, Kurdistan Region of Iraq

Oil Search reports that as at 06:00 hours KRI time on 8 November, the Taza 1 well was at a depth of 3,150 metres and well testing operations were underway.

While stabilising the hole prior to the start of testing, a short section of the drill string was left in the hole. Attempts to retrieve this section were unsuccessful and open-hole testing of the Jeribe Formation commenced on 6 November.

A large volume of drilling fluid, which was lost during drilling, has been recovered, together with gas and oil. The hole continues to clean up and has been producing increasing oil volumes as the test progresses.

Given the sub-optimal hole conditions, with a mechanical obstruction across part of the target interval, the flow of liquid hydrocarbons to surface is very encouraging.

Once testing of the Jeribe Formation is complete, drilling towards the Euphrates target will recommence.

The Taza prospect is located approximately 80 kilometres southwest of the city of Sulaymaniyah. The primary objectives are Miocene and Oligocene carbonates of the Jeribe and Euphrates Formations.
