IP LICENSING UPDATE

Perth, Western Australia – ipernica Ltd (ASX: IPR) advises that its business associate Financial Systems Technology (Intellectual Property) Pty Ltd (FST) has entered into a settlement agreement with Microsoft in relation to the litigation brought against Microsoft in the District Court of the Northern District of Illinois for infringement of its Database Patents. The litigation will shortly be dismissed with the consent of both parties.

The terms of the settlement agreement are confidential and relate only to the family of patents that were the subject of the litigation.

ipernica expects to shortly receive approximately US\$170,000 from FST for its services relating to FST's patents.

ipernica continues to work with FST on its case against IBM.
