Oil Search reports that as at 06:00 hours KRI time on 28 March, the Taza 1 ST2 well was at a depth of 3,260 metres.

During the week, fishing and milling operations were conducted to recover the liner running tool lost downhole. Milling of the tool is currently underway and once complete, the forward programme is to drill ahead to the Euphrates Formation in a 4-1/8" hole.

The Taza prospect is located approximately 80 kilometres southwest of the city of Sulaymaniyah. The primary objectives are Miocene and Oligocene carbonates of the Jeribe and Euphrates Formations.

WELL NAME: Semda 1, Tajerouine PSC, Tunisia

Oil Search reports that as at 06:00 hours Tunisian time on 28 March, the Semda 1 well was at a total depth of 3,702 metres. Drilling progress for the week was 1,102 metres.

No indications of significant hydrocarbons have been observed while drilling the well. The forward plan is to acquire logs and then plug and abandon the well as a dry hole. The logging information acquired will be integrated into Oil Search's western Tunisian regional model and used to evaluate the remaining prospectivity in the Tajerouine PSC.
