Project Overview

- \$1.8 billion, 5 year Christmas Creek Mine expansion awarded in January 2013. Limited Notice to proceed and ramp-up commenced 1 November 2012
- Macmahon's largest ever Mining contract
- Scope of works includes:
 - Drill and blast
 - Overburden removal
 - Ore harvesting
 - ROM rehandle and crusher feed
 - Maintenance of equipment and associated services






Rapid Ramp-up


- Successful recruitment campaign generating 21,875 applications to date from 9,451 unique applicants
- Fast-track recruitment and mobilisation of over 800 mining and construction employees
- Workforce comprised of experienced mine workers with the majority from WA and then QLD
- Focussed Indigenous employment campaign delivering 54 ATSI⁽¹⁾ employees as of 1 May 2013
- Milestone of 500,000 man hours without a Lost Time Injury reached on 20 March 2013 – the project remains LTI free

Plant mobilisation

- Mobilised and put to work 104 dump trucks, 21 D10 dozers, 6 large excavators, 13 wheel loaders, 12 blast hole production drills and associated ancillary equipment
- Fleet includes the Komatsu 930E ultra-class trucks – some of the biggest in the country
- Majority of equipment client owned
- Macmahon project capital expenditure ~\$40 million






Infrastructure Delivery

- 1 x 4 bay workshop, including:
 - Lubricant tank farm, temporary offices, crib rooms and ablutions
 - 1 x dome store
- 2 x satellite facilities, each including:
 - Single bay workshop, refuelling station, office, crib rooms and ablutions
- 1 x minor facility, including:
 - office, crib rooms and ablutions
- Total value approximately \$15 million





Project Update



- First ore harvested on 3 December 2012 only 18 days after first employees landed on site
- Blast hole drilling commenced on 8 December 2012
- Total productive material movement of approximately 10.2 million BCM at end of April 2013
- Establishment and construction of maintenance facilities and satellite infrastructure complete
- Over 1 million tonnes of productive movement in 24 hour period achieved across the combined Christmas Creek mine
- Hub optimisation strategy being considered by Fortescue



Risk Management

- Tyres
 - First year supplied by client
 - Increased allocation in latter years
 - Secured alternate sources
- Explosives
 - Supplied by client
- Fuel
 - Supplied by client
- Water
 - Ground water managed by client
- Initial recruitment
 - Full employment
 - Steady state manning six weeks ahead of schedule
