Oil Search reports that as at 06:00 hours on 20 June, the Hagana 1 well was at a depth of 1,697 metres and preparing to drill ahead in a $12-\frac{1}{4}$ hole.

During the week, 994 metres was drilled and 13-3/8" casing was set and tested.

The Hagana prospect lies approximately 225 kilometres west-northwest of Port Moresby and 10 kilometres northeast from Flinders 1 in a water depth of approximately 105 metres. The primary objective is a submarine, basin-floor fan sandstone of Pleistocene age, with a Pliocene age secondary objective.
