COMMENCEMENT OF DRILLING ACTIVITIES PEL 514, SOUTH AUSTRALIAN COOPER BASIN

The Directors of Planet Gas Limited ('Planet Gas') are pleased to announce the commencement of drilling activities within PEL 514 in the South Australian Cooper Basin.




Figure 1: Location of the Sprigg Field




Figure 2: Location of Sprigg-1 well

The Sprigg-1 prospect is located in the central eastern sector of PEL 514 (see Figures 1 and 2) and is 4.5 kilometres west of Acrasia oil field.

The exploration well will be drilled to a total depth of 2,464 metres to test the oil potential of the Tinchoo Formation up dip and 240 metres west south west of the Reg Sprigg North-1 well. Additional targets will also be intersected through the Murta Formation, Namur Sandstone, Hutton Sandstone, Poolowanna and Arrabury Formations, all of which have recorded hydrocarbon fluorescence in adjacent wells.

The Sprigg-1 well will be spudded in late September 2013.

Planet Gas holds a 20% project interest while Senex Energy Limited ('Senex'), holds an 80% interest and is the operator.

The Sprigg-1 well forms part of the initial farm-in agreement with Senex of December 2011. As part of that agreement, Senex is required to drill two wells prior to November 2013 with the second well currently being planned.
