Australian Agricultural Company Limited – Request for trading halt – Listing Rule 17.1

Australian Agricultural Company Limited ("AACo") (ASX: AAC) requests that a trading halt apply to its securities prior to commencement of trading on Thursday, 12 September 2013 in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

The trading halt is requested pending the release of an announcement regarding a proposed capital raising comprising an accelerated, non-renounceable pro-rata entitlement offer of fully paid ordinary shares. The trading halt is necessary in connection with the institutional component of the entitlement offer, including the related institutional bookbuild.
