The Directors have determined pursuant to Regulation 7.11.37 of the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth) that the persons eligible to vote at the Annual General Meeting are those who are registered Shareholders of the Company at close of business on 20 November 2013.

Terms and abbreviations used in this Notice of Meeting and Explanatory Statement are defined in the Glossary.

ORDINARY BUSINESS

1. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND REPORTS

To receive and consider the financial report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2013 together with the declaration of the Directors, the Directors' report, the remuneration report and the auditor's report.

The reports referred to above are included in the 2013 Annual Report sent to those Shareholders who elected to receive a hard copy. A copy of the report is also available on our website: www.regisresources.com.

2. RESOLUTION 1 – ADOPTION OF REMUNERATION REPORT

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without amendment, the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That, for the purpose of Section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act and for all other purposes, approval is given for the adoption of the remuneration report as contained in the Company's annual financial report for the financial year ended 30 June 2013."

Voting Prohibition

A vote on Resolution 1 must not be cast (in any capacity) by or on behalf of any of the following persons:

- a member of the Key Management Personnel, details of whose remuneration are included in the remuneration report; and
- a Closely Related Party of such a member (including spouses, dependents and controlled companies).

However, a person described above may cast a vote on Resolution 1 if:

- the person does so as a proxy appointed in writing that specifies how the proxy is to vote on the proposed resolution; and
- the vote is not cast on behalf of a person described above.

The Chairman, acting as proxy (by appointment or by default), is expressly authorised to vote all undirected proxies in favour of Resolution 1.

Advisory only

The vote on this item is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

3. RESOLUTION 2 - RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR - NICK GIORGETTA

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without amendment, the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That, for the purpose of clause 17.1 of the Constitution and for all other purposes, Nick Giorgetta, a Director who retires by rotation, and being eligible, is re-elected as a Director."

4. RESOLUTION 3 – RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR – FRANK FERGUSSON

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without amendment, the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That, for the purpose of clause 16.4 of the Constitution and for all other purposes, Frank Fergusson, a Director who was appointed on 14 October 2013, retires, and being eligible, is re-elected as a Director."

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Explanatory Statement has been prepared for the information of the Shareholders in connection with the business to be conducted at the Annual General Meeting to be held at 10am (WST) on 22 November 2013 at the Subiaco Arts Centre, 180 Hamersley Road, Subiaco, Western Australia.

The purpose of this Explanatory Statement is to provide information which the Directors believe to be material to Shareholders in deciding whether or not to pass the Resolutions in the Notice of Meeting.

1. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND REPORTS

In accordance with the Constitution, the business of the Annual General Meeting will include the receipt and consideration of the annual financial report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2013 together with the declaration of the Directors, the Directors' report, the remuneration report and the auditor's report.

2. RESOLUTION 1 – ADOPTION OF REMUNERATION REPORT

The Corporations Act requires that at a listed company's annual general meeting, a resolution that the remuneration report be adopted must be put to the shareholders. However, such a resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

The remuneration report sets out the Company's remuneration arrangements for the Directors and senior management of the Company. The remuneration report is part of the Directors' report contained in the annual financial report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2013.

A reasonable opportunity will be provided for discussion of the remuneration report at the Annual General Meeting.

3. RESOLUTION 2 – RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR – NICK GIORGETTA

Clause 17.1 of the Constitution requires that at every Annual General Meeting one third of the Directors (other than alternate Directors and the Managing Director), or if their number is not a multiple of 3, then such number that is the next lowest whole number of Directors divisible by 3, retires from office and is then eligible for re-election.

Nick Giorgetta retires by rotation and seeks re-election.

4. RESOLUTION 3 – RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR – FRANK FERGUSSON

Clause 16.4 of the Constitution allows the Directors to appoint at any time a person to be a Director as an addition to the existing Directors, but only where the total number of Directors does not exceed the maximum number specified by the Constitution.

Any Director so appointed:

- (a) may retire at the next general meeting of the Company; or
- (b) if the Director does not retire at the next general meeting, *must* retire at the next following annual general meeting of the Company, and is then eligible for re-election.

Frank Fergusson who was appointed as an addition to the existing Directors on 14 October 2013, will retire at the Annual General Meeting in accordance with clause 16.4 of the Constitution and, being eligible, seeks re-election as a Director pursuant to Resolutions 3.

Annual General Meeting means the meeting convened by the Notice of Meeting.

Board means the current board of directors of the Company.

Closely Related Party of a member of the Key Management Personnel means:

- (a) a spouse or child of the member;
- (b) a child of the member's spouse;
- (c) a dependent of the member or the member's spouse;
- (d) anyone else who is one of the member's family and may be expected to influence the member, or be influenced by the member, in the member's dealing with the entity;
- (e) a company the member controls; or
- (f) a person prescribed by the Corporations Regulations 2001 (Cth).

Company means Regis Resources Limited (ACN 009 174 761).

Constitution means the Company's constitution, as amended from time to time.

Corporations Act means the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), as amended from time to time.

Directors means the current directors of the Company.

Explanatory Statement means the explanatory statement accompanying the Notice of Meeting.

Key Management Personnel has the same meaning as in the accounting standards and broadly includes those persons having authority and responsibility for planning, directing and controlling the activities of the Company, directly or indirectly, including any director (whether executive or otherwise) of the Company.

Listing Rules means the official listing rules of the Australian Securities Exchange.

Notice of Meeting or **Notice of Annual General Meeting** means this notice of Annual General Meeting including the Explanatory Statement.

Resolutions means the resolutions set out in the Notice of Meeting, or any one of them, as the context requires.

Share means a fully paid ordinary share in the capital of the Company.

Shareholder means a holder of a Share.

WST means Western Standard Time as observed in Perth, Western Australia.
