

STATEMENT TO AUSTRALIAN SECURITIES EXCHANGE – December 6, 2013 FLIGHT CENTRE TO APPEAL FEDERAL COURT RULING.

THE Flight Centre Travel Group (FLT) intends to appeal today's Federal Court's decision to uphold the ACCC's competition law test case against it.

Based on a preliminary analysis of the judge's findings, the company believes there are errors of law that will form the basis of its appeal.

FLT also believes this morning's Federal Court ruling represents an inappropriate extension of the law that may have implications for retailers and agents in other business segments.

The company does not expect the test case ruling to affect its operations or its business model, as the focus was on a narrow area of activity between 2005 and 2009.

FLT's decision to appeal today's judgment will not affect the scheduled penalty hearing that has been set down for December 19, 2013.
