Bauer-12 Drilling Update

Drillsearch Energy Limited (ASX: DLS) is pleased to provide the attached announcement from the Operator Beach Energy Limited in relation to the results of the Bauer-12 appraisal well in PEL 91 on the Western Flank Oil Fairway.

Drillsearch holds 60% of PEL 91, with Beach holding 40% as Operator.

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About Drillsearch Energy Limited (ASX: DLS), which listed on ASX in 1987, explores and develops conventional and unconventional oil and gas projects. Drillsearch has a strategic spread of petroleum exploration and production acreage in Australia's most prolific onshore oil and gas province, the Cooper-Eromanga Basins in South Australia and Queensland. The company's focus is on 'brownfields' exploration where geological risk is reduced and there is access to existing infrastructure, ensuring that any discoveries can be brought into production.

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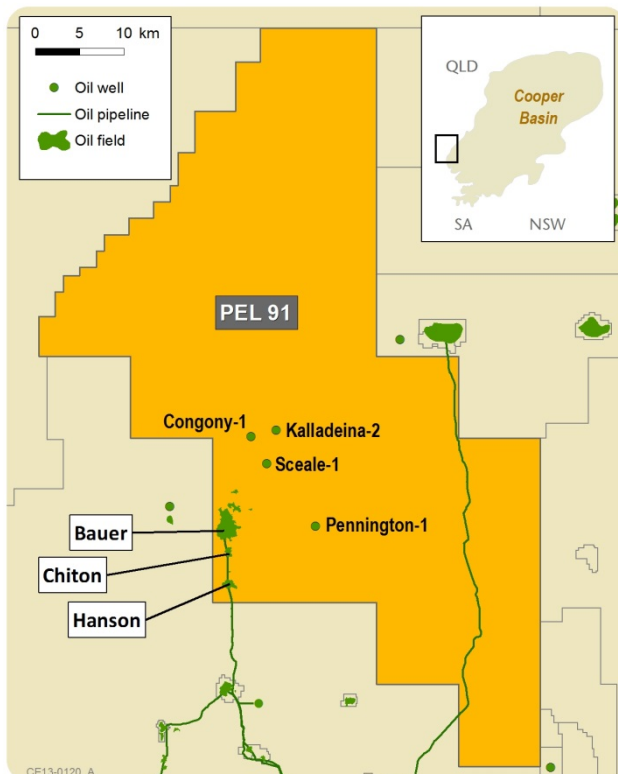

BAUER-12 SUCCESS WITH 2P RESERVES ADDITION

The Bauer-12 appraisal well has successfully intersected a nine metre oil column, five metres of which is in the Namur Sandstone, delivering an upside preliminary 2P reserve addition of 2.5 million barrels

Beach Energy Ltd (ASX: BPT, "Beach") advises that the Bauer oil field in PEL 91 (Beach 40% and operator, Drillsearch Energy Ltd 60%) has increased in size following the drilling of the Bauer-12 appraisal well.

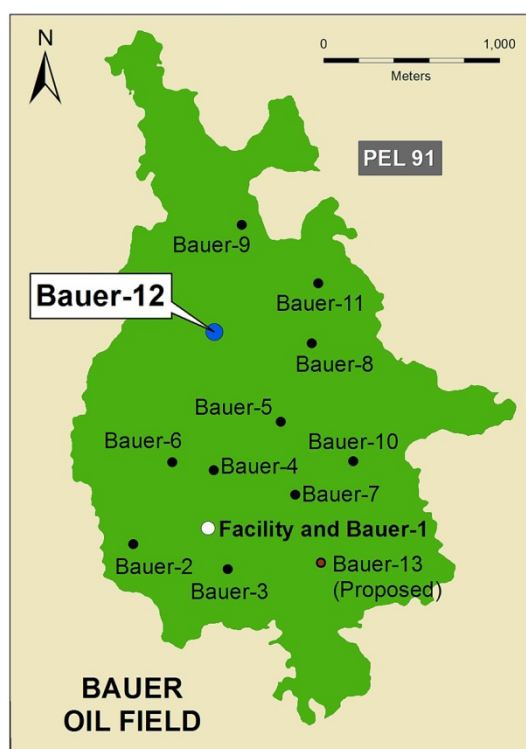
Bauer-12 was an aggressive step out well, intended to address potential in the McKinlay Member and the prolific Namur Sandstone. The well intersected the primary Namur Sandstone target three metres high to prognosis, with five metres of net oil pay. An additional four metre oil bearing interval was also intersected in the overlying McKinlay Member.



These results have extended the areal extent of the field, with preliminary mapping adding 2.5 million barrels to the 2P reserves of Bauer. As a result, Bauer-12 will be cased and suspended as a future oil producer.

Bauer is the largest field on the Western Flank of the Cooper Basin and is producing from eight wells in both the McKinlay and Namur reservoirs, with three further wells yet to come on line.

Production from Bauer is currently in excess of 13,000 barrels per day (gross). With the flowline from Bauer to Lycium having a capacity of up to 10,500 barrels of oil per day, there are currently around seven trucks operational to ensure all production is delivered to the Moomba facility.



Reg Nelson, Beach Managing Director, said “The Bauer oil field is one of the great discoveries that Beach has made, with the field producing above expectations for some time now. Beach has an active forward drilling program in this part of the basin, with a further nine wells in our operated permits expected to be drilled prior to 30 June.”

“For over ten years we have been successful with exploration and development of our oil business on the Western Flank. With 3D seismic covering a significant portion of the region, and a number of prospects and leads from this seismic, we anticipate success to continue for many years to come.”

Following the completion of the evaluation program, the Ensign 930 rig will be moved to the Bauer-13 development well, which is located approximately 1.4 kilometres to the south east of Bauer-12.
