

Drilling Report

10 April 2014

Well Name: Taza 2, Kurdistan Region of Iraq

Oil Search reports that at 06:00 hours KRI time on 9 April 2014, the Taza 2 well was at a depth of 3,189 metres and preparing to drill ahead in an $8-\frac{1}{2}$ " hole into the Jeribe Formation. During the week, wireline logging was carried out and the $9-\frac{5}{8}$ " casing was set.

Taza 2 is located 10 kilometres north-west of Taza 1 and is designed to appraise the hydrocarbon-bearing intervals discovered by Taza 1 (Jeribe/Dhiban and Euphrates/Kirkuk Formations), as well as explore deeper Tertiary and Cretaceous targets including the Shiranish Formation.
