Drilling Report

Well Name: Taza 2, Kurdistan Region of Iraq

Oil Search reports that at 06:00 hours KRI time on 30 April 2014, the Taza 2 well was at a depth of 3,317 metres and preparing to set the $7^{-5}/_{8}$ " liner. During the week, 62 metres of new formation was drilled and wireline logging was carried out over the open-hole section, which includes the entire Jeribe Formation. The logs are being processed for detailed evaluation, but initial analysis confirms the entire Jeribe is oil-bearing. The $7^{-5}/_{8}$ " liner will isolate the Jeribe from deeper units which, from Taza 1, are known to be higher pressure.

Taza 2 is located 10 kilometres north-west of Taza 1 and is designed to appraise the hydrocarbon-bearing intervals discovered by Taza 1 (Jeribe/Dhiban and Euphrates/Kirkuk Formations), as well as explore deeper Tertiary and Cretaceous targets including the Shiranish Formation.
