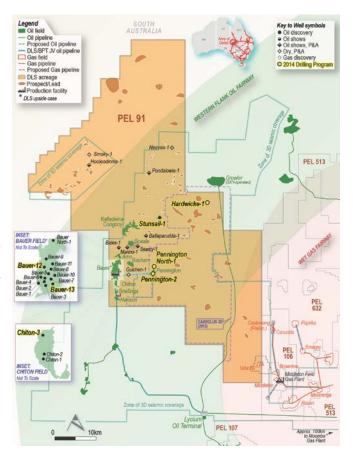
## **April Drilling Report**

### Oil Business

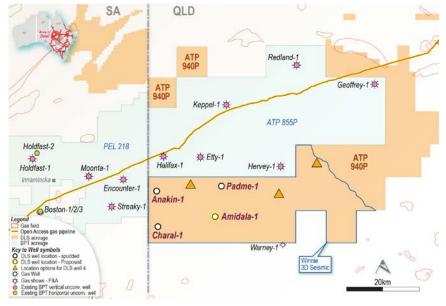
#### Western Flank Oil Fairway PEL 91

In PEL 91 (Drillsearch 60%, Beach 40% and Operator) Hardwicke-1, an exploration well targeting the McKinlay/Namur Sandstone reservoir, was drilled to a total depth of 2,150 metres. The well encountered a water-bearing McKinlay/Namur interval along with strong shows in the Birkhead Formation, which was the secondary target. A drill stem test (DST) was conducted over the lower Birkhead interval but only recovered drilling fluid from the drill string, indicating minimal influx. Although the shows observed are encouraging for future exploration in the area, there was insufficient hydrocarbon pay in the well and it was subsequently plugged and abandoned.

Pennington-2, a deviated appraisal well located approximately 250 metres to the south west of Pennington-1, spudded on the 29 April 2014. The well encountered good oil shows in the McKinlay/Namur interval with a gross column height of 5 metres in the McKinlay and 7 metres in the Namur. Shows were also observed in the lower Birkhead Formation but over a poor net-to-gross section which did not justify a DST. Based on the excellent results seen in the primary McKinlay/Namur target, the well is being cased and suspended as a future oil producer. Pennington-2 was the first well of a two-well campaign to appraise the Pennington oil discovery. Pennington North-1, a near-field exploration well located 900 metres north of Pennington-1, will be the next well in the campaign.

The Charal-1 well reached total 3,866 metres Ωf subsequent to the end of the March quarter. Following the casing and suspension of Charal-1, the rig will move to Anakin-1 where similar deepening of the well will take place. It is expected that hydraulic stimulation and production testing will commence during the September quarter taraetina the REM shale sequence and the Patchawarra tight gas sandstones.
