The Directors of Skydive the beach Group Limited (ASX:SKB) advise that the Company has now completed the acquisition of the two thirds of the Ballina drop zone operated by Skydive the Beach Byron Bay Unit Trust, as foreshadowed in the Prospectus dated 5th March 2015.

The consideration for the acquisition was \$90,000 in total and has been settled through the issue of 360,000 shares in the Company, issued in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 7.1.
