Bevan Slattery new Interim Superloop CEO

Superloop Limited (ASX:SLC) today announced that Superloop Executive Director and Founder, Mr Bevan Slattery will be taking the role of Interim CEO of Superloop.

As Interim CEO, Mr Slattery will be leveraging his significant industry expertise to accelerate a number of major initiatives within the organisation including acquisition integration, product innovation and automation, accelerating business development and focus on a number of important strategic sales opportunities.

Mr Daniel Abrahams will move into the new Chief Infrastructure Officer position focusing on the concurrent delivery of Project Red Lion in Singapore and deployment of the recently announced 110km fibre network in Hong Kong, with both projects critical to the continued success of the company. Mr Abrahams will also be continuing with strategy refinement both as an Executive and member of the Board.

Mr Slattery said that Mr Abrahams would continue to run the core Superloop business as it was prior to the recent acquisitions with particular emphasis on the critical elements of network construction and completion. Daniel will spend significant time in both Singapore and Hong Kong to deliver these strategic infrastructure projects.

"I'm essentially focusing on rapidly building the overlaying services network by integrating the recently acquired managed services businesses with our key network assets" Mr Slattery said.

This will enable Superloop to deliver new, innovative products targeting customer requirements that we can take to market in the next few months.

It is expected that this arrangement will continue operate in place until the Project Red Lion and the Hong Kong network is completed which is expected around December, 2016.

"2016 is the year of execution for Superloop and I'm delighted to be working with Daniel and the team to execute our vision," Mr Slattery said.

Mr Slattery will remain in the role of company Chairman.

Superloop's initial key assets include a 15-year exclusive right to a 130 kilometre fibre network within Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne connecting many of the key data centres within those metropolitan areas.

The Company owns and operates a strategic underground duct network spanning approximately 120 kilometres in the Asian telecommunications hub of Singapore. The Singapore fibre optic network interconnects major data centre and submarine cable landing station locations including Equinix SG1, SG2, Global Switch, Digital Realty (Jurong), Katong and Tuas Cable Landing Stations, and will soon directly connect to Equinix SG3.

Recently the group acquired APEXN and CINENET.

APEXnetworks offers the Company's Channel Partners and Customers the ability to manage their network services with access to a wide product set, a service qualification tool, with everything managed via an in-house designed Network Management System and hosted Web Portal product.

CINENET is Australia's only high-speed broadband data network created specifically for screen media industries. It's a shared, connected infrastructure for studios, producers, editing facilities, visual effects providers, sound facilities and DVD producers to create and exchange large digital assets and connect to infrastructure providers.
