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Company Report (Appendix 4C)

Enclosed is the Quarterly Report (Appendix 4C) for the 3 months ended 31 March 2016.

The Company's cash balance at 31 March 2016 was \$2,428,000 in funds held. The Company also retains undrawn financing facilities of \$720,000, giving a total access to cash of \$3,148,000.

During the quarter, the total cash balance increased by \$723,000 notwithstanding substantial investment expenditure on product development.

The major factors in the operating cash increase during the quarter were:

1. An inventory decrease of approximately \$500,000.
2. The beneficial impact in the following (March) quarter of the reduced debtor collections in the month of December together with the prepayment of creditors leading into Christmas, amounting to approximately \$350,000.

Including the above factors, net operating revenues for the period saw a net cash inflow of \$1,054,000.

Investment activities amounted to an outflow of \$331,000 made up of fixed asset expenditure of \$17,000 and further product development work capitalized of \$314,000.

There was nil expenditure on financing activities.


