Hong Kong Update

Superloop Limited (ASX: SLC) is pleased to provide an update on progress of its core Hong Kong network and its TKO Express domestic submarine cable project between Chai Wan on Hong Kong Island and Tseung Kwan O Industrial Estate on the mainland.

Construction of the 110km Hong Kong core network is on track for completion during December 2016, with the overall cable installation 95% complete. Hong Kong network progress can be tracked at www.superloop.com/network/hongkongprogress.html

In addition, the Company advises that the two-month public objection period has successfully closed, with no outstanding objections on TKO Express. The construction programme is on schedule and cable installation works will commence during November this year, with completion on track for early 2017.
