Cooper Energy Limited (ASX: COE) reports that Butlers-9, an oil appraisal well located in PPL 245 Cooper Basin, South Australia, announced 7 December 2016, is being plugged and abandoned after reaching a total depth of 1,810 metres in the Merrimelia Formation. Minor hydrocarbon shows were recorded in the well.

Cooper Energy Limited holds a 25% interest in PPL 245, with the balance held by the Operator, Beach Energy Limited.
