amaysim Australia Limited (ASX Code: AYS) Correction to Appendix 3B and Cleansing Statement lodged on 30 December 2016

amaysim Australia Ltd (**amaysim**) lodges the attached Appendix 3B to correct certain typographical errors in the Appendix 3B lodged on 30 December 2016. The revised Appendix 3B corrects the previous Appendix 3B by:

- 1. amending Parts 1.2 and 1.6e (the number of ordinary shares issued) by deleting the number "2,143,406" and replacing it with the number "2,183,406";
- 2. amending Part 1.6i (amaysim's remaining issue capacity under rule 7.1 and rule 7.1A) by deleting the number "27,844,320" and replacing it with the number "27,850,320";
- 3. amending Part 1.7 (issue dates) by deleting "1 January 2017" and replacing those words with "30 December 2016"; and
- 4. amending Part 1.8 (number and class of all securities quoted on ASX) by deleting the number "185,628,802" and replacing it with the number "185,668,802".

On 30 December 2016, amaysim also lodged a cleansing statement pursuant to section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) in respect of the same issuance of ordinary shares in amaysim (**Cleansing Statement**). The Cleansing Statement also contained the same typographical error in respect of the number of shares issued. Accordingly, by this notice, amaysim corrects the Cleansing Statement by deleting all references to the number "2,143,406" and replacing them with the number "2,183,406".
