Retirement of Michael Brockhoff as Managing Director

"It has been an honour to work with the team at MaxiTRANS and my colleagues on the Board and I look forward to watching the company build on this platform further to deliver superior value for shareholders."

The Board has commenced a search process to appoint a replacement for Mr Brockhoff and will advise when that process is complete.
