Hong Kong Network Update – TKO Express

Superloop Limited (**ASX: SLC**) is pleased to advise that marine installation of TKO Express, the Group's new low-latency domestic submarine cable between Chai Wan on Hong Kong Island and the data centre hub of Tseung Kwan O (TKO) Industrial Estate on the mainland, is complete. Cable installation at the TKO beach manhole occurred yesterday, Sunday 19 February, with full end to end testing of the cable to commence today.

Comprising a total of 1,728 fibre cores, TKO Express is the world's highest core count subsea cable ever deployed. Once provisioned it will provide a significant reduction in latency to the other fibre paths to the data centre hub at Tseung Kwan O and will create the first truly geographical diverse path to the Hong Kong Stock Exchange and other critical data centre locations. Chai Wan and TKO are home to some of the most significant data centre infrastructure in Hong Kong and having the most direct connection between them will enable new opportunities for many of Superloop's key customers.

Mr Bevan Slattery, Superloop Executive Chairman and CEO, said, "To see more than 2 years of hard work and effort in designing, planning and now finally building TKO Express culminate in this landmark achievement is a testament to our vision to be the leading provider of digital connectivity services in the Asia Pacific region."

The project team now move on to complete the testing and commissioning of TKO Express into the wider Hong Kong 2,000 fibre core backbone network. The cable is expected to be available for customer access during March 2017.
