Takeover offer - Norwood Park Limited (update)

Propel Funeral Partners Ltd (ASX: PFP) (**Propel**) announces that its takeover offer for Norwood Park Limited (**Norwood Park**) closed at 7pm on Tuesday, 13 February 2018. As at the time the offer closed, Propel's subsidiary, FV (ACT) Pty Ltd (**Bidder**), had voting power in Norwood Park of 95.12% (based on the acceptances it has received from Norwood Park shareholders and on the basis of information provided by Norwood Park).

It is intended that the consideration payable for the shares, being a total amount of approximately \$13.0 million, will be processed and/or cheques dispatched by the Bidder to the accepting shareholders on 6 March 2018.
