In December 2017, TIG's Russian subsidiary, OOO Beringpromugol, entered into an agreement with Sberbank, Russia, to provide a RUB 600 million credit line. The credit line matures in December 2018, with funds available for drawdowns through July 2018 and repayments due from August through December 2018. Interest on the facility is accruing at 9.90% per annum on amounts drawn down and unsettled as at the interest calculation dates. In addition to pledging the mobile fleet owned by the Group, the credit line is secured by cross guarantees provided to OOO Beringpromugol by the other Russian subsidiaries. As of 31 March 2018, RUB 432 million of the aforementioned credit line had been utilised.
