## Parliamentary committee recommends changes to proposed legislation for post-2020 telecommunications industry

Parliament's Economic Development, Science and Innovation Select Committee has published today its report on the Telecommunications (New Regulatory Framework) Bill, which outlines telecommunications industry regulatory settings from 2020 onwards.
