TRANSITION OF CHAIRPERSON

Agrimin Limited (ASX: AMN) ("Agrimin" or "the Company") advises that its Non-Executive Chairperson, Mr Brad Sampson, has informed the Board of his intention to transition from the Chairperson role to that of a Non-Executive Director following his appointment as Chief Executive Officer of Kore Potash plc.

Accordingly, the Company is commencing a search process to recruit a new Chairperson. Mr Sampson will continue as the Chairperson of Agrimin until a new appointment is made to ensure an orderly transition.

Mr Sampson has been Non-Executive Chairperson of Agrimin since April 2016, over which time the Company's market capitalisation has grown from A\$12 million to more than A\$140 million as it has advanced the Mackay SOP Project including the successful completion of a Pre-Feasibility Study earlier this month.
