

**Final development consent approval for Minto and Patons Lane construction well underway**

Bingo Industries Limited (“**Bingo**” ASX:BIN) today announced the receipt of final development consent to increase throughput limits and build an advanced recycling facility at Minto resource recovery centre (“**RRC**”) in Sydney, together with an update on the progress at Patons Lane.

**Development consent granted for Minto**

Development consent was recently granted by the Department of Planning and Environment NSW. The development consent will see the approved capacity at the site increase from 30,000 tonnes per annum to 220,000 tonnes per annum and is an important milestone in the journey to 3.4 million tonnes network capacity by the end of FY20.

The approved development scope of works includes the extension of the existing shed to fully enclose the processing facility. Development works will commence in Q1FY19 and it is anticipated that the site will be redeveloped and operational in Q3FY19.

**Construction Update at Patons Lane**

The development of a Resource Recovery Centre at Patons Lane in Orchard Hills commenced earlier this year, with significant progress occurring on site since May 2018. Leading building contractor Vaughan Constructions has been appointed to design and construct the recycling facility, whilst local contractor Mulgoa Quarries has been engaged to deliver the bulk earthworks component of the project.

Redevelopment is on track and is anticipated to be operational in July 2019.

Overall, Bingo’s development program and resulting capacity uplift remains largely on track, with 3 of the 11 redevelopment projects (noted at the half year results) already delivered and key sites in both Victoria and New South Wales progressing well.
