• IMF announces the confidential settlement of an investment it has funded in Australia, with anticipated revenue of approximately \$3.9 million

Settlement - Australian Case

IMF Bentham Limited (**IMF**) announces the settlement of an investment it has funded in Australia. The terms of the settlement are confidential.

IMF currently expects to recognise revenue of approximately \$3.9 million from this investment and profit after capitalised overheads (but before tax) of approximately \$2.3 million. This investment is part of IMF's on-balance sheet portfolio.
