# **Sydney Airport Traffic Performance January 2019**

Sydney Airport CEO Geoff Culbert said, "January was a strong start to the year for International traffic, processing 77,000 more passengers than the prior corresponding period (pcp) and 56,000 more than the busiest month in 2018. Domestic passenger numbers were flat compared to the pcp, resulting in a total 2.0% growth in total passenger traffic for January.

"The earlier timing of Lunar New Year celebrations this year contributed to the growth of international passengers from celebrating nations in late January. A diverse number of Asian carriers all experienced material load factor improvement this month, as Sydney has one of the largest and best attended Lunar New Year Festivals outside mainland China.

"Domestic carrier loads and capacity were broadly flat for the month. Our analysis suggests there are a number of factors impacting domestic airlines including fleet issues, industrial relations challenges and capacity management.

"Double digit passenger growth on three of our top 10 markets - China including Special Administrative Regions (20%), United States of America (11.1%) and India (10.6%) - continues to reinforce our diverse market mix and opportunity."
