Results of Extraordinary General Meeting on 14 June 2019

The Food Revolution Group Limited (ASX: FOD) wishes to advise results of its Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) held today, Friday 14 June 2019.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 3.13.2 and section 251AA of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), the following information is provided in respect of each resolution considered and voted upon at the EGM.

FOD convened the EGM to enable shareholders to vote on resolutions relating to FOD's \$20.25 million strategic agreement with Careline Australia Pty Ltd and its founder and Chairman Dr Tao (Norman) Li, as announced by the Company in September 2018.

All 3 resolutions concerning the strategic investment of Dr Norman Li and Careline Australia Pty Ltd and /or its nominees were passed .

Details of proxy votes are in respect of each of the resolutions numbered as set out in the Notice of Annual General Meeting, dated 10 May 2019.
