Ungani 6H - Weekly drilling report

Buru Energy Limited (Buru Energy) provides the following update on operations at the Ungani 6H well as at 0600 hours Tuesday 18 June 2019.

Since the last report the well has been drilled ahead in 171 mm (6 3/4 inch) hole to a total measured depth of 2,390 metres. The Ungani Dolomite was encountered as predicted at a measured depth of 2,380 metres with the bottom hole location some two vertical metres below the top of the Ungani Dolomite.

The 5-1/2 inch (140mm) casing string was then run into the hole but encountered obstructions in the Ungani Shale from 2,358 metres to 2,380 metres. A decision was taken to pull the casing from the hole and run a cleanout trip with a drill bit.

This bit trip was unsuccessful in satisfactorily cleaning the hole in the shale section due to the amount of time the shale has been exposed. The decision was then taken to undertake a short sidetrack through the shale section prior to re-running the casing, and the current operation is running in the hole to set the cement plug for the sidetrack.
