ASX ANNOUNCEMENT

MARKET GUIDANCE: PRELIMINARY RESULTS FOR FY19

Academies Australasia Group Limited ('Company') today announced that management accounts (unaudited) show that in the year to 30 June 2019 (FY19):

- a. Revenue from ordinary activities is expected to have increased by 6% from \$62.8 million in FY18 ('Previous Corresponding Period' or 'PCP') to \$66.3 million; and
- b. Earnings before interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation ('EBITDA') after significant items is expected to have increased by 30% from \$6.9 million (PCP) to \$9.0 million.

[Note: 'EBITDA' and 'significant item' are not terms prescribed by the Australian Accounting Standards ('AAS'). The Board considers that 'EBITDA after significant items' provides a better understanding of the underlying performance of the business.]

The higher education operations of Academies Australasia Polytechnic were the main contributor to the increase in revenue and EBITDA. FY19 saw the commencement of their second Bachelor Degree: Bachelor of Business (Leadership and Management).

These preliminary results are, by far, the best in the Company's 111 years of operation. The Board is pleased with the above noted preliminary results and looks forward to confirmation by the audit that is currently in progress.

The Board is also delighted to confirm that the aggressive debt reduction programme that commenced a few years ago was completed in the middle of June 2019. The Company continues to be debt-free.
