Voting Entitlements

Pursuant to the Corporations Act, the Directors have determined that the shareholding of each shareholder for the purpose of ascertaining the voting entitlements for the Annual General Meeting will be as it appears in the Share Register as at 7.00pm (Sydney time) on 5 November 2019.

Lodgement of a Proxy

The lodgement of the proxy form (and any Power of Attorney under which it is signed) must be received no later than 10:00am (Brisbane time) on 5 November 2019, being 48 hours before the commencement of the meeting. Any proxy form received after that time will not be valid for the scheduled meeting.

VOTING RESTRICTIONS

Item 2 (Remuneration Report)

Members of the company's key management personnel and their closely related parties (as defined in the Corporations Act) are prohibited from voting on Item 2 (Remuneration Report) and any such votes will be disregarded by the company, unless:

- (a) the person is voting as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote in accordance with the directions specified on the proxy form; or
- (b) the vote is cast by the chairman of the meeting for a person who is entitled to vote where the person has expressly authorised the chairman to exercise the proxy.

The chairman of the meeting intends to vote all available proxies in favour of Item 2 (Remuneration Report).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

These Explanatory Notes are important and should be read carefully.

Item 1 (Re-election of Director – Gary Smith)

FLT director since 2007, Gary has vast tourism industry experience and has served on a diverse range of boards and tourism industry related bodies during the past 30 years. Gary is a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and the Institute of Chartered Accountants. He is also a director of Michael Hill International Limited (from Feb-16) and National Roads and Motorists' Association Limited (the NRMA) (from Feb-19).


Gary is FLT's Independent non-executive chairman. He is also a member of FLT's Remuneration and nomination committee, and the Audit and risk committee.


Item 2 (Remuneration Report)



Proxy Form

How to Vote on Items of Business

All your securities will be voted in accordance with your directions.

APPOINTMENT OF PROXY

Voting 100% of your holding: Direct your proxy how to vote by marking one of the boxes opposite each item of business. If you do not mark a box your proxy may vote or abstain as they choose (to the extent permitted by law). If you mark more than one box on an item your vote will be invalid on that item.

Voting a portion of your holding: Indicate a portion of your voting rights by inserting the percentage or number of securities you wish to vote in the For, Against or Abstain box or boxes. The sum of the votes cast must not exceed your voting entitlement or 100%.

Appointing a second proxy: You are entitled to appoint up to two proxies to attend the meeting and vote on a poll. If you appoint two proxies you must specify the percentage of votes or number of securities for each proxy, otherwise each proxy may exercise half of the votes. When appointing a second proxy write both names and the percentage of votes or number of securities for each in Step 1 overleaf.

A proxy need not be a securityholder of Flight Centre Travel Group Limited.

SIGNING INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTAL FORMS

Individual: Where the holding is in one name, the securityholder must sign.

Joint Holding: Where the holding is in more than one name, all of the securityholders should sign.

Power of Attorney: If you have not already lodged the Power of Attorney with the registry, please attach a certified photocopy of the Power of Attorney to this form when you return it.

Companies: Where the company has a Sole Director who is also the Sole Company Secretary, this form must be signed by that person. If the company (pursuant to section 204A of the Corporations Act 2001) does not have a Company Secretary, a Sole Director can also sign alone. Otherwise this form must be signed by a Director jointly with either another Director or a Company Secretary. Please sign in the appropriate place to indicate the office held. Delete titles as applicable.
