## Appendix 3B - 2016-2019 Long-term Incentive Vesting of Performance Rights

Mastermyne Group Limited (ASX Code: MYE) ("Mastermyne" or "the Company") is pleased to announce the vesting of Performance Rights issued in November 2016, in relation to 2016-2019 Long-term Incentive Plan.

All vesting conditions were achieved over the three year measurement period.

Mastermyne Chairman, Col Bloomfield, said "the vesting of the Performance Rights to executives firmly supports the objectives of the Long-term Incentive Plan to attract, motivate and retain executives. It encourages individuals to participate in the company through ownership of shares. Additionally, it drives improvement of Mastermyne's performance by aligning the interests to those of the shareholders and the Group. The Company performed superbly over this vesting period and all rights have subsequently vested."

The Total Shareholder Return (TSR) achieved during the vesting period (1st Oct 2016 – 1st Oct 2019) was 507.7%.
