Contract to supply Powershore system for Barangaroo Station development

Acrow Formwork and Construction Limited (ASX:ACF) is pleased to announce that it has received a significant order from BKH Group for the sale of the Acrow Powershore high load shoring system, to be used as part of the formwork solution for the construction of the Sydney Metro Barangaroo Station.
